Gods, graves, and scholars: The Story of Archaeology (1951)

A classic work describing the adventures of famous archaeologists--very readable

The march of archaeology (1958)

Another book by Ceram, similar to Gods, Graves, and Scholars, but this one tells the story with many photographs and illustrations

Invitation to archaeology. (1967)

A good introduction to the field, including the different methods used

An introduction to modern archeology (1972)

Describes the combination of anthropology and archaeology in which interpretation of what was found is added to the description of what was found

Physical anthropology and archaeology: Introductory readings (1976)

Chronological selection of papers in these fields; parts on archaeology and methods used

The Cambridge encyclopedia of archaeology (1980)

Many articles on the different discoveries around the world; has section on dating methods

The wonderful world of archaeology (1968)

Introduction to the field, with a chapter on Method and Science (chap. 4) and a glossary of terms
